Funds Available for BPI Training

Newburgh New York. Newburgh Community Action Committee, Inc., is excited to announce we have received funding through the Federal Stimulus Program to offer training to residents of Newburgh and Orange County to complete Building Analyst Training and eventual certification through Hudson Valley Community College. NCAC will be covering the costs of this training. The Building Analyst Training consists of reviewing building shells, combustion safety, heating/ cooling issues and home solutions. It also includes seasonal building considerations, cost effectiveness of different systems, sample energy and air infiltration audits and testing. Rudy LaMarr (Executor Director of NCAC), states, " This training affords an excellent opportunity to empower people to become more self sufficient as they will gain the skills to seek employment in the green industry which represents the jobs of the future."

The classroom training will be offered at Newburgh Community Action Committee at 123 Grand Street, 3rd Floor Newburgh. Instruction will be provided by Hudson Valley Community College and the first class began December 7th, 2009 at NCAC. The initial class was comprised of 12 individuals with future classes currently being scheduled. Additionally, the training consists of 40 hours of mandatory classroom training including scheduled field work.
